

#### General Care Instructions for Maintaining Marble:

- Use a vacuum to sweep up loose dirt
- Use a damp cloth to wipe the furniture regularly but avoid acidic or abrasive cleaners as it will damage the sealant on the stone and hence making it more vulnerable to staining
- Use a poultice paste to remove stubborn stains. Spread it onto the stain, then cover with plastic wrap sealed with painters' tape. Once it is dry (12 to 24 hours), scrape the paste off and wipe with a damp cloth.
- Seal the marble as it will repel staining agents, but note that it does not make it stain-proof
- Marble cannot withstand acid or acidic ingredients, such as citrus, vinegar and tomato as it will etch the marble. Any acidic fluids that is spilled on marble surfaces must be wiped off immediately. Use coasters and trivets and do not place hot objects directly on the surface
- Do not drop anything heavy on marble as it will create 'stun marks' which are white dots that cannot be removed or repaired
