

General Care Instructions for Maintaining Solid Wood:

- Regularly dust the furniture with a dry, lint-free cloth
- When wiping the furniture with a damp cloth, it is always a must to wipe it quickly after with a dry cloth
- To maintain the natural colour of the wood as much as possible, avoid placing the furniture under direct sunlight as much as possible
- For any spills onto the wood, quickly dab it and wipe it off
- Always use trivets or hot pads as a base for hot objects
- If there are water marks, use a slightly damp cloth to wipe it off and allow the moisture to evaporate on its own
- If you are using a sandpaper to rub down the marks that have been accidentally caused by pens and crayons, rub the sandpaper in the same and singular direction as the wood grain.

General Care Instructions for Maintaining Veneer:

- Regularly wipe the furniture with a slightly damp, lint-free cloth
- When wiping the furniture, wipe it in a singular direction
- When wiping the furniture with a damp cloth, it is always a must to wipe it quickly after a dry cloth
- To maintain the natural colour of the wood as much as possible, avoid placing the furniture under direct sunlight as much as possible
- Always use trivets or hot pads as a base for hot objects
- Always use coasters for glasses and mugs, and felt pads for glass bowls
- It is best to not use aerosol cleaners or polishes on wood veneer surfaces, including polishes that contain waxes, abrasives or are oil-based
